FIELD NOTES

July 8, 1954. While searching for fingerling SH holding pond sites, this creek was briefly visited in company with Gerald Holman. This stream, a tributary to Pieta Creek, was dry at the point of observation approx. ½ mile above and below the bridge crossing on the Highland Springs road (T13N R11W Sec. 35). Above this point for several hundred yards there has been recent bulldozing operations perhaps for the removal of gravel, which has completely changed the character of the stream bottom. At present the channel is similar to the cross-section of a shallow bowl with high gravel levees. This may be modified following winter runoff. - HEP/mm
